## **COVID-19**

As we continue to navigate and adjust to new operating practices, we are eager to collaborate with our community and clients to facilitate event production. Our priorities are to manage an environment in which our guests, clients, vendors, volunteers and employees feel safe and abide by best practices. ORE is committed to partner closely with local Alberta Health Services Inspectors and municipal law enforcement and share up-to-date guidelines as it relates to COVID-19 and public gatherings.

- Venue Access
  - Public should be limited to controlled points of entry (participants to enter at west end of Pavilion, spectators are recommended at the east end of arena and foyer)
  - Time Slot schedules to enable distancing of participants and
  - Participants to bring their own supplies and handle their own equipment to reduce sharing of high-touch objects; where sharing is required, clean and disinfect equipment
- Physical Distancing
  - Individuals MUST maintain physical distancing of 2 metres during the event, including when arriving to, and leaving from, the event
  - Occupancy will be enforced if physical distancing is not adhered to
  - Masks or face shield encouraged to be worn, mandatory if not proper physical distancing
- Cleaning & Sanitization
  - Hand sanitizers will be located in the arena and foyer

## Rules

To ensure the safety of all participants, please read General Rules & Regulations below:

### Participants must:

- **Wear: helmet, riding boots** (no rubbers/muck boots), long sleeved shirt
- Be ready to enter/exit the arena promptly when it is his/her turn
- Treat riders, volunteers and horses respectfully
- Flag a horse that kicks with a red ribbon in tail, be attended to at all times or tied outside
- Have proper tack (saddles and headstalls must be used)
- Enter and leave arena on walk

### Participants must refrain from:

- Elastic or any methods of tying feet into stirrups
  - Velcro keepers on saddle seats, mandatory keepers on saddle fenders, lace up footwear
  - Riding stallions, foals running at large, dogs unleashed
  - Excessive use of crops, over unders, and spurs
  - Tying horses to panels
- 
- Sportsmanship is to be promoted at all times
  - In the event that the electronic eye malfunctions, a re-run will be issued.
  - Participants may enter up to 2 horses. Second horse would enter as a drop-in with drop-in fees associated with it and will not qualify for points."
  - Horses not competing will not allowed in arena/holding areas.
  - No tying to panels.

## Barrel Racing

Riders enter at the red line, circle around the 1st barrel, proceed to the 2nd barrel, and then continue on to the 3rd where they will complete the pattern and finally exit the course crossing the red line a second time. This pattern is often referred to as a "Cloverleaf". The pattern may also begin with the left barrel first.


### Penalties

Add 5 seconds for each barrel knocked over

### Disqualification

Going off pattern

Crossing back over the starting line before completing the pattern



## Pole Bending

A rider and horse run past a timer line to the end of a line of six poles, then turn the end pole and weave down through the pattern, again turn at the last pole and weave back up, then run back home across the timer line. The fastest time will win.

### Penalties


Add 3 seconds for each pole knocked over

### Disqualification

Going off course

Going over finish line before completing course

When running doubles, going over centre line



## Thread The Needle

Course will be set up using 5 poles as shown on the diagram.

The rider will run from the start line between the first four poles, turn around the 5th pole (in either direction), run back through the four poles to the finish.

### Penalties

Add 3 second penalty will be added for any of the first four poles that are knocked over


### Disqualification

Knocking over the 5th pole (end pole).

Going off course - If the horse and rider do not enter the poles through the middle of the first set, the rider may stop the horse, back him up and continue with the pattern as it should be. The rider may not turn the horse and return to where they broke the pattern or they will be disqualified.

Crossing the center line if running two at a time.

Going over finish line before completing course



## Hat Race


Use the end pole from Thread the Needle with a hat/cap on it. Riders ride down, turn pole and take hat off and head for finish.

### Penalties

Add 3 second penalty will be added if pole is knocked over

### Disqualification

Going over finish line before completing course
