Stall Rental

- All Vendors must be pre-registered, no Drop in vendors allowed
- Vendor contract must be submitted and approved
- \$25/space/week (all stalls are 10ft wide with space to drive in)
- \$10 Junior Vendor Space per week (must be 18 years and under and all products sold to be made by junior vendor; table & space only no drive in)
- Vendors must provide their own tables & chairs
- Payment made by: cash, cheque, e-transfer: farmersmarket@oldsregionalexhibition.com
- Regular vendors are welcome to pay in full for the year or by month. These vendors will be assigned designated spaces for the duration of the season when possible.
- Casual vendors will be placed in available spaces each week

Products

- All products or services a Vendor wishes to sell must be listed on their application and approved by the Market Manager. Products not listed must be approved by the Market Manager.
- What can't be sold at the Farmers Market
 - Fruit from outside of Canada
 - Tobacco, Vaping products/equipment
 - Marijuana including edibles.
 - Used items and antiques, flea market items
 - Live animals
 - Anything that is illegal to sell/trade or own in Canada.
 - Weapons
 - Food item AHS has not approved for sale at farmers markets.

Hours of Operation/Setup

- Vendor Move-In & Move Out Hours:
 - Group A: 1:30pm 2:00pm
 - Group B: 2:00pm 2:30pm
 - Group C: 2:30pm 3:00pm
- Public Hours:
 - Thursday's 3:30pm 6:30pm
- All Vendors must be in place by 3:00 pm
- All goods, and displays must be within the area you have been assigned.

Food Vendor Requirements

- Food vendors must follow all food safety training and paperwork required by AHS for the items they are selling and must bring a paper photocopy for the Market Manager on their 1st market day. Food safety training and permits if required by AHS.
- All AHS rules and regulations must be always followed. Items being sold outside of the AHS guidelines may not be sold.
- All claims made about a product must be backed up. Organic must be certified, cures – treats – must have medical studies recognized by health Canada etc.
