- ✓ All Agriculture Commerce is considered **Non-Restricted Services** and must follow general and sector specific guidance; ORE is committed to delivering a “livestock auction” option for clients and guests as it is deemed an essential service
- ✓ Please do not attend programming if you feel unwell
- ✓ Please wear a mask or face shield when entering indoors
- ✓ Please utilize hand sanitizer at numerous stations
- ✓ Please maintain a 6’ physical distance at all times
- ✓ Please send a designated representative to attend programming
- ✓ Please do not handle products not intending to purchase
- ✓ Please do not leave children unattended while onsite
- ✓ All food service must be approved by ORE
- ✓ No liquor service permitted on site
